

A Very Simple Way to Make the Whole World Happy

[Translator's comment.]

The author of this book, Mr. Seiji Kobayashi, seriously advocates the "realization of a moneyless society. And the "realization of a money-free society" may be the "decisive factor" to solve various "social problems" that will occur in the near future all at once.

In his booklet, "A Very Simple Way to Make the Whole World Happy," he seriously advocates that the entire society can be made happy simply by creating a "circular economic and social system" with people who have three minds:

"1, The Heart of Growth," "2, The Heart of Altruism," and "3, The Heart of Belief

Even if you don't have money, you don't have to worry about anything. In fact, various social problems of our time can be solved at once. (For more details, please read this book written by Seiji Kobayashi.)

However, in a society that continues to be a mature "capitalist society," it is difficult to suddenly try to "realize a society without money. This is because the "law of inertia" is at work in the movement of society, both culturally and economically.

Indeed, money is the best "device" invented by mankind, but the existence of AI (Artificial Intelligence), which is highly developed through technological innovation, has resulted in many unemployed people whose jobs have been lost. If the government implements MMT (Modern Monetary Theory) and introduces Basic Income, people's awareness and the value of money will change drastically.

People today are "stressed" in various ways, feel "difficulty" in living, want to "commit suicide," and question their ". purpose of existence"

The current 'advanced capitalism', which forces 'Bullshit Jobs' (jobs that don't fucking matter) at its core, may in fact be a very fragile entity, as it may seem.

What kind of mature society will come after the highly developed capitalism?

The answer is found in this book, "A Very Simple Way to Make the Whole World Happy.

Some readers may think that it is difficult to realize such a society because what is written is quite radical, but it is very essential and gently written.

What is innovative and essential is not difficult to understand and can be expressed in words that even children can understand. I would be very happy if this book could help people learn about the society that will come after highly developed capitalism and help them regain their true nature as human beings.


What kind of waste is

eliminated?

[Material waste]

Isn't today's capitalist society a competitive society, with supermarkets, home electronics retail stores, and convenience stores all competing with each other in a small area? If there is no money, there is no need to compete, so there should be only one store in the area. We can reuse a lot of building materials. There would be lots of surplus land. And since we don't have to sell extra, we can minimize waste. Japan wastes twice as much food as the number of people

who starve to death in the world. That is also very wasteful.



Next, without money, the concept of ownership disappears. You can use things freely, for example cars, because there are several types of cars in the local car park with keys, and you can use them freely. Today it's a mini car, today it's a family car, on special occasions it's a super sports car, and so on. On the other hand, if you take very good care of the car, you can use one car of your own. Anyway, each person doesn't need to have extra things, so the world is only supplied with the necessary amount. Companies don't need to make a profit either, so they don't have to produce or sell anything unnecessary.



In the end, everyone will be able to identify what they really need. When you receive something that doesn't require money, you are receiving the feelings that reside in that item. When the focus is on the thought, the recipient thinks, "Do I really need this right now? Therefore, they will receive only the minimum necessary items. And since the company is not concerned with profit, there is no need to stimulate unnecessary consumption.

It's true. That's great. What other waste can be saved?


[Human waste]

The next step is going to be technological innovation. Even if a very good technology is developed now that we have money, we can't spread the technology quickly because we would lose jobs. For example, let's talk about a sophisticated generator. If an eco-friendly generator could be developed that could cover the electricity needs of an area just by placing one of those generators in that area (autonomous community center), would that generator spread? If it spread, the national power grid would no longer be needed, and nuclear power plants would no longer be necessary. So the people who work there would be in trouble. That is why it cannot spread. Even if it is a very good technology.

The same is true for hospital drugs and treatments. If a complete cure for a disease were developed, the hospital would not be able to make money and would go out of business. Therefore, even if a perfect cure is developed, the hospital will go out of business. In the field of automobiles, Toyota, Nissan, Honda, Mazda, Subaru, and others can bring their technologies together to develop the

ultimate eco-car, and self-driving trucks will soon be available. If

that happens, truck drivers will be able to do other jobs.



Next, the concepts of unemployment and work will change. There is no money, so there is no concept of unemployment, no concept of employment. In the new world, if you want to work for the benefit of others, you will be able to search for a job in your area with a single smartphone and do the work you want to do, for the hours you want to do it. Those who want to do the same job can do so, and those who want to pursue different things freely can do so. As there is no concept of employment, there is no need for documents or interviews when entering a job. At that time, people who want to make

everyone smile through that work will be able to come together and work.

What a fun job to do in such a workplace, don't you think?

Yup. That kind of work sounds like fun and, sure, I'd love to work for free!

At the end of human waste, the various jobs that are created because of money will disappear. Just eliminating the concept of unemployment and employment eliminates a lot of waste, but it also eliminates jobs related to social security, taxes and registration. Supermarket cashiers will disappear, security jobs will disappear. There will be no more surplus jobs because the disruptive shops will eventually converge into one. The world will be full of unemployed people (laughs), but that's fine. All those people will be able to do the job they want to do with just one smartphone, 20 hours a week, and the economy will develop considerably faster than it does now.

Amazing! Maybe you can save some other waste?

[Spiritual waste]

Isn't the world today bound by many things? Time, institutions, such things will be changing rapidly. Everyone will work freely, so there will be no system where Saturdays and Sundays are holidays, and all days of the week will be someone's holidays and weekdays too.

If this happens, for example, leisure facilities will no longer have waves of quiet on weekdays and busy on weekends. There would always be a moderate number of visitors, and a relaxed, happy time would spread. The roads are not crowded only in the mornings or on holidays. The world will become a place where people spend their time with a more relaxed spirit than it is now, because everyone will spend their time with a free spirit.

That's the kind of world I want to spend time in!!

In such a world, where people are mentally relaxed, they will change about love. The concept of ownership will disappear. Our children, our families, our children belong to everyone and are supported by everyone. It will not be a love of taking, but a love of sharing. If this happens, love will spread more and more throughout the world. The concepts of family and adultery will disappear, and the world will become a place where people can love each other more freely.

A world full of love, huh?
What on earth is beyond that?


If love spreads throughout Japan, then Japan will make the whole world happy. People who have used the surplus from [Material waste] and have become more comfortable with [Human waste], using the love deepened by [Spiritual waste], will go to the whole world and bring love to the region by contributing to it, without dividing it.
